FULL JOB SUMMARY

The development director serves as an extension and ambassador of Esperanza International in the United States. S/he will be responsible to increase, strengthen, and diversify Esperanza's funding sources through various strategies and will be expected to meet annual fundraising goals. This is an entrepreneurial position. To succeed, the candidate must be an internally-compelled self-starter who is willing and able to take initiative in establishing a long-term, vibrant and engaged constituency of Esperanza supporters throughout the country. Additionally, the candidate will be expected to assist in providing marketing strategy and execution as well as oversight of the current development team and its expansion both in the US and the Dominican Republic in future years.

RESPONSIBILITIES

To recruit resources to promote and fulfill the mission and vision of Esperanza International

Engage and develop growth strategy with Esperanza's Executive Board

Actively work with the CEO and senior staff to develop and implement a comprehensive development strategy to include corporate, foundation, government grants, etc. in order to support the organization's growth

Retain 85%+ of major donors and 70% of other relationships in the US

Achieve 20% increase in funds raised year over year from new and inherited donors

Hold at least 30 face-to-face meetings on a monthly basis and document in Esperanza's database

Plan or coordinate at least 1 national fundraising event annually

Facilitate meetings and introductions of high-impact supporters with Esperanza's President

Manage and develop current development staff in US and DR

Recruit staff, interns and volunteers to work with Esperanza domestically and abroad

Mobilize and accompany donors to visit Esperanza's programs in the DR

15% of time will be travel to areas where Esperanza has strong support to deepen relationships: Orlando, Seattle, Dallas, and New York
